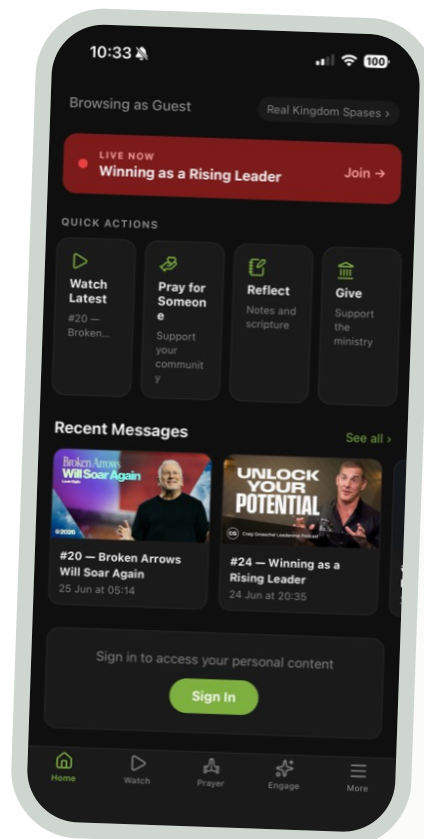

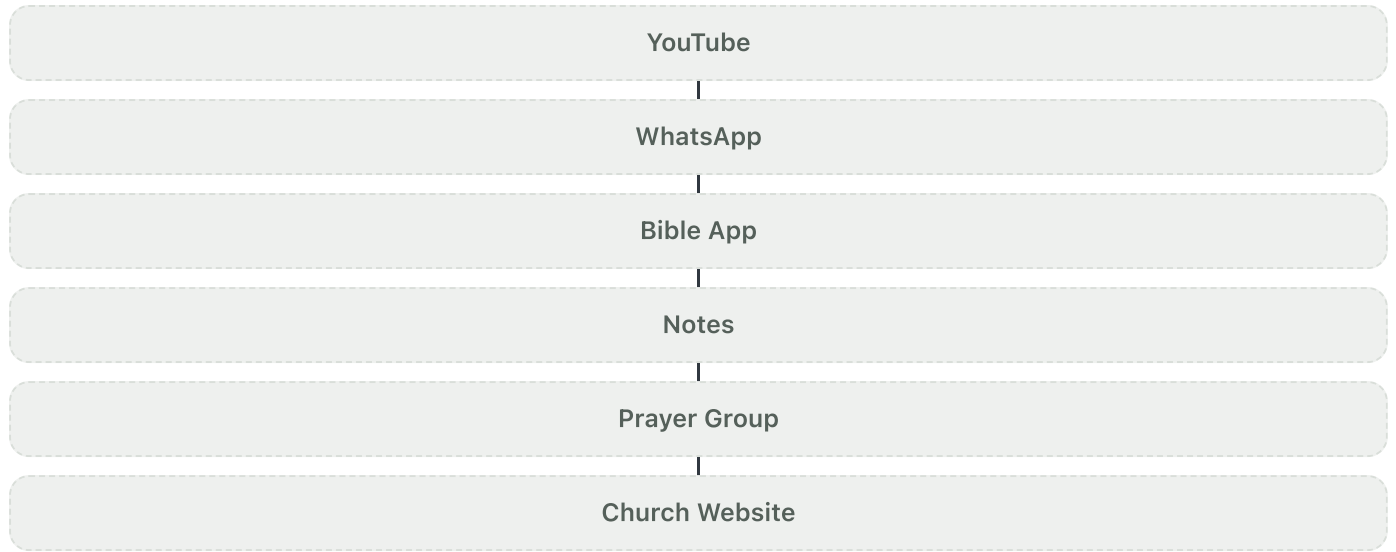

Churches learned to stream. Few learned to disciple digitally.

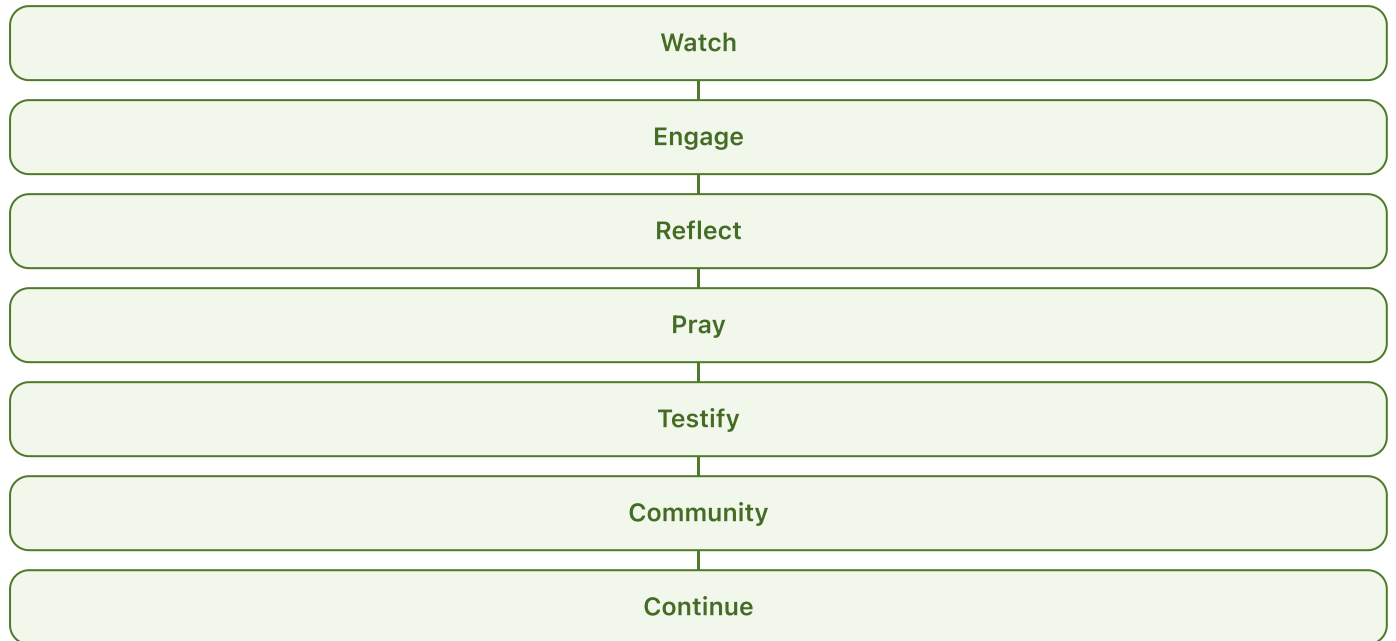
Every meaningful moment happens in a different place — and becomes disconnected. The result isn't too many apps. It is **fragmented discipleship**.

THE MISSING LAYER

Most platforms solve broadcasting. Kingdom Spaces solves participation.

The Engagement Layer is not another feature added to a livestream. It is the connective tissue that links watching, reflection, scripture, prayer and testimony into a continuous discipleship experience.

Instead of asking, "How do we stream church?" it asks, "How do we help people engage with God throughout the week?"

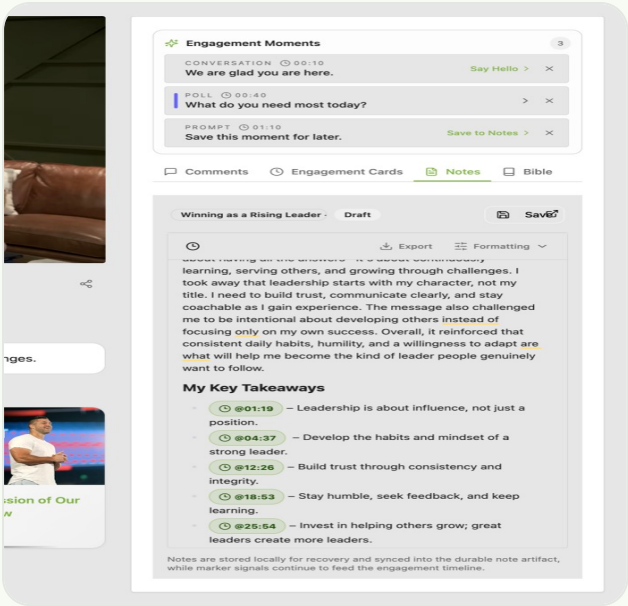

MINISTRY BEYOND THE BROADCAST

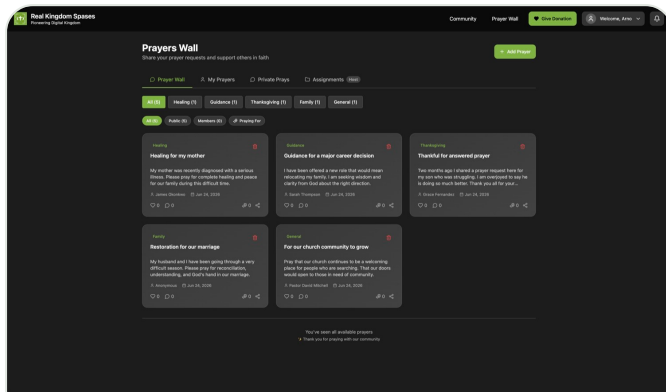
Ministry doesn't end when the stream ends.

Every church has moments that deserve to continue — a prayer request, a conversation, a testimony, a need, a relationship. Kingdom Spaces was designed so

those moments don't disappear when someone closes the livestream.

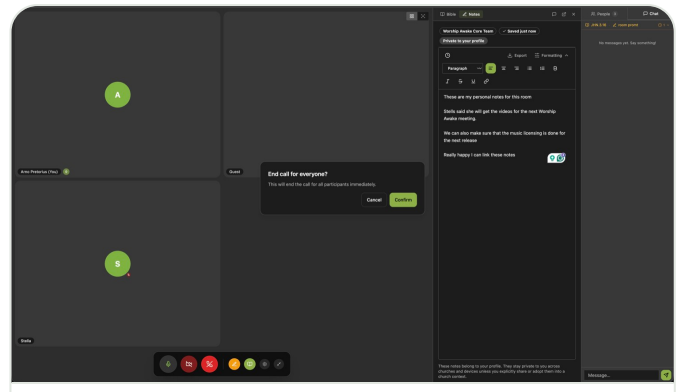
Ongoing rather than event-based — a public wall, private prayer assignments, and live one-to-one prayer calls.

Voice, video and discussion spaces for authentic connection beyond the broadcast — with shared notes and Bible built in.

Testimony — capture testimonies, share them through QR codes, and encourage others through real stories of God's faithfulness.

PLATFORM STRUCTURE

Spaces built around church life.

The platform is structured around the different rhythms of church participation — gathering, engagement, community and care. Each space holds a specific kind of moment.



Gather Spaces

Where the church gathers. Services, events and livestream gatherings — live engagement happens here.

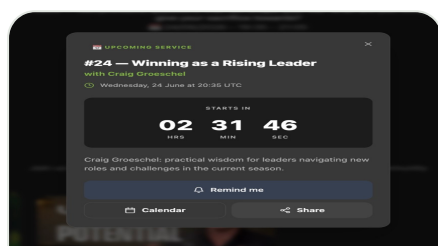


Prayer Spaces

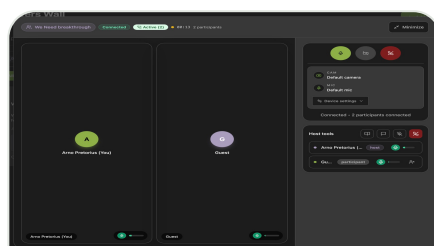
Where care and ministry happen. Prayer requests are received, assigned and followed up with intention.

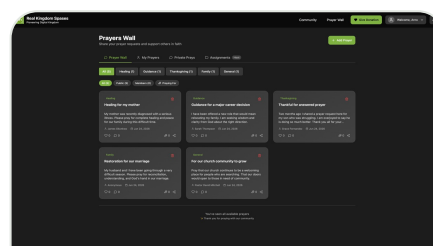
Built for the real moments of ministry — from the reminder before a service to a live prayer call afterward.

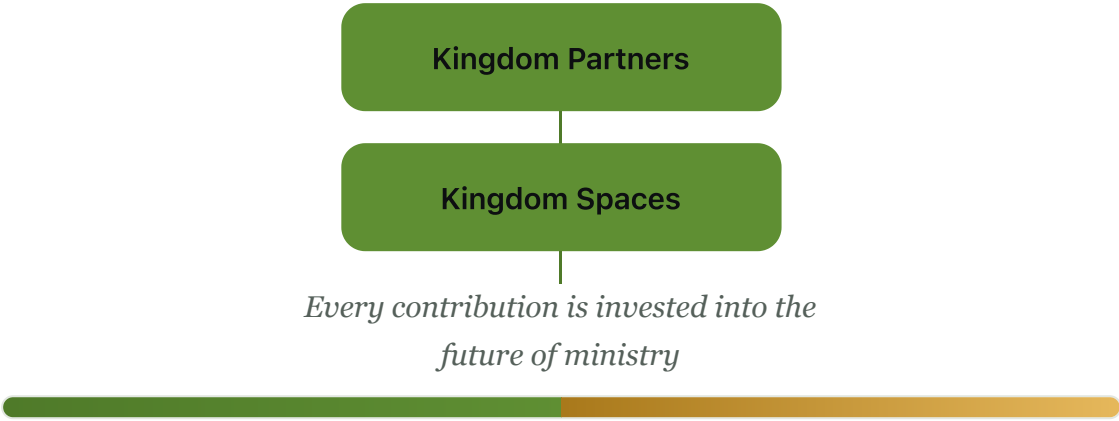
